 COVID-19 PROTOCOL
 (revised 8-1-22)

Pleasant View bases precautions on COVIDActNow.org measurement of transmission risk for the Harrisonburg Metro Area. COVID Transmission risk rates will be reviewed weekly on Thursdays and the protocol will be followed for 7 days until the next Thursday. (If there is a sudden spike in risk rate, PVI may initiate more restrictive protocol.)

High Risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Encourage virtual or telehealth visits as possible. -Encourage use of medical grade, KN-95 or N-95 masks by individuals. If individual is unable or reluctant to wear a mask, encourage alternative use of face shield. -Encourage social distancing. HDP to encourage staggering of space while also social distancing. -Follow COVID-19 Visitation Protocol and utilize COVID-19 screening questions (document) for visitors. Visitation should take place outdoors, or in garage where appropriate. -Staff are <u>encouraged to wear medical grade masks</u> while working at PVI. -N-95 masks are required during active outbreak in house. 				
Medium Risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Encourage virtual or telehealth visits as possible. -Encourage use of medical grade, KN-95 or N-95 masks by individuals. If individual is unable or reluctant to wear a mask, encourage alternative use of face shield. -Encourage social distancing. -Follow COVID-19 Visitation Protocol and utilize COVID-19 screening questions (document) for visitors. -Staff must wear masks while working with individuals. N-95 masks are required during active outbreak in house. 				
Low Risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Visits and community activities allowed with screening (document). Recommend to use masks, social distancing. -Follow COVID-19 Visitation Protocol and utilize COVID-19 screening questions (document) for visitors. -Staff must wear masks while working with individuals. -N-95 masks are required during active outbreak in house.
