

In this understanding, Pleasant View hosts monthly Faith and Light services geared to minister to individuals with disabilities and their families. Our pastor, Dave Gullman, leads worship and teaching in multi-sensory ways to provide opportunities for embracing the message of God’s love and grace.

Through a worship team, a handbell choir, and dramatic presentation individuals participate in the service and teaching.

Pleasant View currently serves about 100 people residentially and through Faith and Light, the potential is so much more. As the only chapter in Shenandoah Valley, we hope to expand this ministry to reach more individuals with disabilities and their families with resources for spiritual understanding and growth.
